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### How To Write An Assessment

Start the report with an executive summary. Phrase the report's topic in the form of a question. For example, the main query of an educational assessment might be, "What has been the impact of new literacy standards on instruction materials for high school seniors?" Define key terms in the next paragraph.

The first paragraph of your assessment essay is the introduction. Here, you'll introduce the reader to the work that you're about to discuss while also presenting your thesis statement. Your thesis statement is the one sentence that tells the reader what the rest of the report will be about.

Divide your topics into columns to make a good assessment of your arguments. Next, make two columns by drawing a line down the center of a piece of paper. Use one side of the paper for the arguments you will use to advocate your position and on the other side list opposing argument to your position.
